



We have new policies in place to ensure the safety of our customers and staff members. This is our highest priority. Your co-operation during this uncertain time is greatly appreciated.

We are encouraging all our customers to book prior to arrival for dining and drinking as tables will be limited and we cannot guarantee you will be able to be seated if you walk in.

The maximum booking will be for 6 guests. There will be no variation from this. Tables outside can be booked, however, if the weather changes we may not be able to move your booking indoors due to limited tables.

Our opening hours are changing. This is detailed below and applies to bar and restaurant

- Monday 5 – 9.30pm (Food only for residents)
- Tuesday 12 - 2.30, 5 - 9.30pm
- Wednesday 12 - 2.30, 5 - 9.30pm
- Thursday 12 - 2.30, 5 - 9.30pm
- Friday 12 - 2.30, 5 - 9.30pm
- Saturday 12 – 9.30pm
- Sunday 12 – 9pm

We would ask that you DO NOT visit the restaurant if you feel unwell in any way. Our staff will be asked to follow the same rule.

We will be offering table service only. Please do not come to the bar. We will take orders and payments at the table.

We will still be able to take cash but card payments are encouraged. Contactless payments are now possible up to £45. We will disinfect our card machine between uses.

Upon arrival you will need to wait at the entrance to be greeted by one of our members of staff. There will be hand sanitiser provided and we will endeavour to maintain a 1m+ distance.

We will be taking contact details (Name and telephone number) for **ALL** bookings including walk-ins. This is so we can provide information for the NHS Test and Trace system, and this is a council requirement.

There will be a reduced menu in the early stages of our opening, but we will endeavour to offer a similar menu to pre-closure as soon as we are able.

All cutlery & condiments will be brought to the table once you have ordered and all glasses will be changed between drinks (you will not be able to refill the same glass).

Toilets – only one person is to use the toilet at one time, apart from with children when we will ask for all children to be accompanied. If you need to wait for use of the toilet please maintain social distancing. An extra sanitiser station will be provided for your use outside the toilets.

The toilets will be cleaned more frequently during opening hours. Pinch points and the outdoor play area will also be cleaned regularly throughout the day.

We are using a one way system throughout the building. There are signs indicating which direction to go.
